
### **FEEDBACK - ALUMINI**

The Alumni feedback form consisted of questions that truly indicated their satisfaction level with the curriculum. Given below are the conclusions obtained by analyzing the alumni feedback for the academic year 2022-2023.


- Most majority of the alumni members (81%) agreed that relevancy/ sufficiency of the courses meeting the industry requirements.
- Around 78 per cent of them agreed that experiences gained through projects/ internships/ certifications facilitated more employability skills/ communication skills/ confidence among them.
- Curriculum included value added courses or soft skill training or domain specific electives for enhancing constructive learning are agreed by 66 per cent of them.
- Scope of syllabus was enough in enhancing entrepreneurship skills or lifelong learning or human values and ethics are agreed by 56 per cent of them.
- Almost 77 per cent of them agreed that scope of the curriculum has developed creativity, leadership, innovation, self-motivation, workplace ethics, and social responsibility.
- Curriculum facilitated in acquiring the learning outcomes of the programme of study is agreed by 66 per cent of them.
- Various platforms and opportunities facilitated by the Institution helped to achieve your goals are agreed by 66 per cent of them.
- 57 per cent of the alumni members are agreed that curriculum facilitated enhancement of practical competencies as needed by the industry.
- Almost 65 per cent of them agreed that they have participated in various academic initiatives by the institution during the course.
