





#### **ALUMNI ASSOCIATION**

During the year, the association conducted a wide variety of programmes for the development of the college. The alumni meetings of different batches were conducted in the college. The association were collected old books and handed over it to the college library. The PDC 93-95 batch donated Desks and Benches amounted Rs. 15000/- to college during this academic year. Some of the unique programmes taken up by the association during the year are listed below;

#### **Cycle Challenge**

As part of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations of our college, the Alumni Association organized a program called Cycle challenge. Our students usually make use of private buses as means of transportation. As there were not enough number of buses plying in the route, many students find it difficult to reach college on time. They had to wait for long hours to get back home as well. It is at this juncture that the alumni Association came up with this novel idea of providing cycles to the needy students. Hon Minister for Higher Education, Dr. R. Bindu inaugurated the formal function of Cycle Challenge on 26 March 2022.

Cycles which have a number as well as the name of our college printed on them were distributed to the students. They were requested to return the cycle once their course is over. In addition to solving the transportation problem of students, the scheme aims to instil environmental awareness by using non-polluting vehicles for transport. It also enhances the physical and emotional well-being of students. It is with pride that we acknowledge the fact that our college is the first of its kind to execute such a unique program as Cycle Challenge. The second phase of the programme were inaugurated by the Principal Sri A.K. Suresh on 23/11/2023 by distributing 15 cycles to the students. Altogether 65 cycles were distributed to students through this programme.

#### **Mobile Phone Library**

As a result of the widespread Covid pandemic, regular offline classes were suspended and all educational institutions in Kerala switched over to online education. Most of our students hail from extremely poor financial backgrounds and hence could not afford to buy a computer or mobile phone for attending online classes. This was when the Alumni Association rose to the occasion and suggested this unique plan to provide mobile phones for deserving students so that they can resume their classes online. The staff of our college, Alumni and retired staff contributed generously and we were able to buy around 50 mobile phones. Hon Minister for Higher Education, Dr. R. Bindu, formally inaugurated the program online on 24 July 2021. During this academic year many of the students were utilised the scheme and the college could manage the problems of non-availability of gadgets for academic needs of the students.

#### BIRD'S CLUB

In our college we are having 45 students of various disciplinaries as active members of Birds club.






# <u>Activities</u>

On 12/12/2022 a meeting of the members of Birds club was organised in the campus and discussions were held on providing food and water to the birds in the coming summer season. Accordingly we have provided water sources in the form of filled up earthen wares at various points in our vast campus.

The club members also came up with suggestions to provide food and water to birds in their houses also and happily implemented the same, there by plays a major role in environment protection and Bio – diversity.





A review meeting was held on 16/01/2023 and the students reported the progress in the activities. It was decided to form a core club of students to monitor the maintenance of the food and water sources on a weekly basis.

On 09/02/2023 we conducted a meeting of the members of Birds club. We had decided to increase the scope of activities of Birds club from next academic year onwards. It is decided to organise camps for bird watching in close co ordination with department of Forests at various places like Peechi, Thattekkad, Marottichal, Kumarakom etc.

Also decided to conduct census of birds available in our campus with cooperation of Zoology departments of our nearby colleges.

A birds photography competition will be held in coordination with the college union so as to create the awareness and spread the message of need of protection of Environment among our students.








# **DEBATE CLUB**












## **English Association Inauguration**








#### Talk on Indian Theatre by Padmasri Dr Neelam Mansingh Chowdhry






## One Day Poetry workshop on 'Unravelling the Poetic Denoument' by Sudeep Sen








# DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

The Onam celebrations were conducted in the department on 1/9/2022. Both faculty members and students of the department actively participated in the event.



5. On 27/02/2023 PTA meeting was held for 1st and 2nd year BSc Statistics students in offline mode.




